### Arete Scholars Participating Schools Policies and Procedures

- Participating schools will allow Arete to list their school on our website ([www.aretescholars.org](http://www.aretescholars.org)) as an official Arete Scholars participating school.
- Participating schools agree to follow the rules and procedures put forth in R.S.47:6301 and Bulletin134, as amended.
- Participating schools will not combine an Arete scholarship with another LDE scholarship program.
- Arete mails quarterly payments to the participating school on the student's behalf. Prior to each payment, schools must verify enrollment. Award checks are made payable to the parents and they must restrictively endorse the check over to the school.
- Arete requires that the school provide notice within five (5) business days of a student's withdrawal. Upon receipt of notification from a qualified school that a student who has received a scholarship has ceased to be enrolled in the school, the school tuition organization shall cease making payments to the school for that student.
- Scholarships granted to qualified students shall be portable during the school year and can be used at any qualifying school within the designated fund to which the scholarship was originally awarded and accepts the qualified student.
- Participating Schools agree to provide Arete the following information regarding participating students at least annually, as applicable. All submitted documentation will remain confidential and is for research purposes only. Any information obtained will be used for aggregate reporting purposes.

### Louisiana Law Requirements for TDR Participating Schools

*Schools are solely responsible for reading, understanding, and following the rules and procedures set forth in R.S.47:6301 and Bulletin134, as amended. Please visit [www.louisianabelieves.com](http://www.louisianabelieves.com) for the law in its entirety. Schools participating in the Tuition Rebate Program are required by Louisiana Law to meet the following requirements:*

- Qualified Schools must conduct criminal background checks on employees in compliance with La. R.S.17:15
- Qualified Schools must annually administer the state math and English/Language Arts (ELA) and any relevant End of Course tests to students who receive funding through the TDR program.
- Qualified Schools shall annually provide Arete with their current tuition and fees document. The tuition and fees reported for TDR students may not be higher than these published fees.
- Qualified Schools must abide by the Enrollment of Scholarship Receipts guidelines as set forth in Bulletin 134, Chapter 11.
- Qualified Schools (that have been in business less than five years) that receive more than \$50,000 in scholarship donations from a school tuition organization (STO) shall demonstrate its financial viability by filing, prior to the start of a school year, a surety bond payable to the STO in an amount equal to the aggregate amount of donations expected to be received during the school year.
